TEACHER ROUNDS DAY - Tuesday, March 10th -

As we embark upon planning for the day, the following information might be helpful in making our work more meaningful and valuable.

Our Purpose:

To learn and grow together! The goal is to create a special time where teachers can come together and learn from each other in order to increase our instructional excellence. It is always non-judgmental and not evaluative.

Our Focus:

How are students engaging with the content through reading, writing, speaking, or listening? This is really what's at the heart of content-area literacy. This essentially includes any group work, projects, presentations, discussions, readings, or writings students might do in a classroom.

Our Process:

We observe and collect data on what *students* are doing. It's important to remember the focus is not the teacher. We might ask ourselves: How are students starting class? How do students transition from one activity to the next? How are students interacting with one another? How are students engaging with the content through reading, writing, speaking, or listening? What are students being tasked to do? What work are students producing? We then engage in inquiry: What else do we want to know? And, finally, we reflect: How we could adapt what we have observed for our own classroom and content?
