• Chico Community Scholarship Association (CCSA) – Deadline: January 19, 2024

• Tri Counties Bank Scholarship Program – Deadline: March 13, 2024

Scholarships are awarded to high school seniors — especially, though not exclusively, to those who are economically disadvantaged — who demonstrate interest in public service, community engagement and business entrepreneurship.

Tri Counties Bank offers two types of scholarships:

- Income Based Sixty (60) \$1,500 scholarships are awarded to students with a Student Aid Index (SAI) of 0 or less, and a minimum GPA of 2.5.
- Merit Based Twenty (20) \$1,000 scholarships are offered to students with a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.
