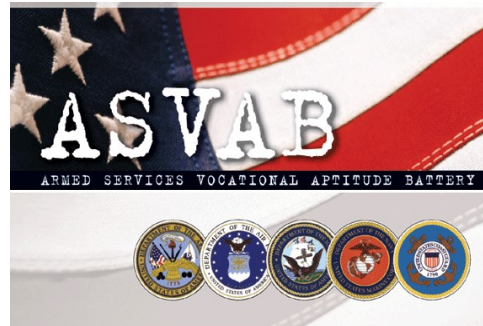

PRELIMINARY SAT NATIONAL MERIT SCHOLARSHIP QUALIFYING TEST

The Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (PSAT/NMSQT) will be offered **Saturday, October 19th**. This test is useful in providing practice for the SAT, allowing Juniors to enter the National Merit Scholarship Corporation competitions for recognition and scholarships, assessing your skills in critical reading, mathematical reasoning and writing, getting specific suggestions on how to improve your skills, comparing your academic skills with those of other college-bound students, asking colleges to send you information, and getting information about college majors and careers.
