● **Elk's Most Valuable Student (MVS) Contest** – Deadline: November 15, 2021

The Elks National Foundation (ENF) awards 500 four-year scholarships based on academics, leadership, and financial need. National awards range from \$1,000 per year to \$12,500 per year. The national awards will be announced in April 2022. State and local awards are also available to students applying.

- Pursuing a four-year degree on a full-time basis (minimum of 12 semester hours), at a U.S. college or university next school year.
- Current high school seniors (or equivalent) who are citizens of the United States are eligible to apply.
- Applicants do not have to be related to a member of the Elks.

● **Andy Peek Livestock Scholarship** - Deadline: December 8, 2021

Eligibility Criteria:

- Graduating high school senior or undergraduate student
- Presently or planning to attend a junior college, state college, or university
- Plans to major in Agricultural Studies (priority consideration for those entering the livestock industry)

● **Elk's Legacy Awards** – Deadline: February 7, 2022.

The Legacy Awards program begins on September 1, 2021. Legacy Awards provide \$4,000 scholarships for children and grandchildren of dues-paying Elk members. The ENF offers a total of 350 national awards.

● **Chico Community Scholarship Association (CCSA)** – Deadline: FEBRUARY 9, 2022

CCSA awards scholarships to seniors from the Chico Unified School District area. Graduating seniors who plan to enter accredited college or vocational training programs after high school are eligible to apply. Student applications, including essay, are screened by CCSA members as well as individual scholarship donors. - **Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) Submission** – the **priority deadline for submission is March 2, 2021** for Cal Grant and other state and federal aid for the 2021-2022 school year.
